Dear Parents and Carers

We wish to assure you that a considerable amount of planning and preparation has already begun to enable all pupils to have the opportunity to return to school later this month. The Minister's announcement last week stated that the purpose of a return is for children to 'Check in, Catch up and Prepare'.

We have already produced our own very detailed proposals however until we receive official Welsh Government Guidance on how schools should approach reopening we will not share our plans with parents/carers and pupils as they may be subject to change, depending on the detail in this guidance. We expect this guidance to arrive this week.

To this end, I wanted to forewarn you to expect a detailed letter from the school shortly, outlining exactly what the opportunity to 'return to school' will look like for your child and to enable you to make an informed decision.

Thank you for your feedback so far and thank you to the children who provided feedback at the student voice session this week.

We will therefore be in touch with my next update shortly.
