Re: Planned Phased Re-opening

Owing to a decision taken this afternoon by the local authority, I write to inform you of the changes to our planned phased re-opening.

Ministers and trade unions have not been able to reach agreement on the school term ending on 24th July 2020. Consequently, schools in Monmouthshire will now open for three weeks, rather than four. The end of the academic year will now be Friday 17th July 2020.

Please be assured that this decision is not ours alone and not because of a reluctance of any members of staff at our school.

As I am sure you will be, we are genuinely sorry that this additional provision will no longer be available. We wanted nothing more than to be able to provide your child with as much face-to-face teaching and learning as possible.

Next week, at our Wellbeing/Expectations week we can discuss how this may affect you and your family.
